


# GOOD NEWS for GUISBOROUGH

(Proverbs chapter 16 verse 25).*




*'For all have sinned

*'But God demonstrates his own love for us  
in this: While we were still sinners, Christ

*Jesus said 'I am the Good Shepherd; I  
know my sheep and my sheep know me -  
and I lay down my life for the sheep'.  
(John chapter 10 verses 14-15).*

We must now ask him to  
rescue us. Knowing that he will  
keep us safe forever.

*'If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus  
is Lord', and believe in your heart that  
God raised him from the dead, you will  
be saved'.*

running away from him.

*'Whoever comes to me I will never  
drive away'.*


(John chapter 6 verse 37).
