If your doctor phoned you and in a very serious voice said, "Please come in as soon as you can. I have something to discuss with you," you would know he has bad news!

Your first response might be, "No, I don't want to know." But you go because it is only when you know the diagnosis that you can learn the cure.

If there is something wrong with us we need an expert diagnosis. We want to know exactly what is wrong with us and what the cure is. We don't want a 'rough guess' or the 'nearest estimate'. We don't want a 'possible cure'.

When it comes to our spiritual health God is the only one who can really tell us what is wrong with us - and the way that we can be put right again.

God does have some bad news about our spiritual condition.

He tells us that when Adam and Eve ate the forbidden fruit (which was against His clear warning); God told Adam that all mankind would die spiritually and physically - and that is what happened.

Many years later we read these words '*you were dead in your sins*'. That's the bad news - for all of us.

But God also has some good news - He also gave the solution to our problem. He promised a Saviour (Genesis 3 verse 15). The apostle John tells us, '*Grace and truth came through Jesus Christ*' (John 1 verse 17).



But how does that help? Jesus came into the world to bring God's grace, something that none of us deserve because like Adam we have all sinned.

But Jesus also came to reverse what sin brought. He came to be the way (John 14 verse 6), the *only* way that we can be brought back to God. He came to '*save His people from their sins*' (Matthew 1 verse 21).



So those who were dead in sin; God can make alive by forgiving us all our sins.

How can we receive His forgiveness? We must turn away from our sin to Him and turn to God and ask for His forgiveness - this is God's way. It is His *only* way.

Are you really sure of your destiny?

Listen to what God the Great Doctor has to say in the Bible about your spiritual condition.

Then accept the cure He has provided - the gift of salvation through Jesus Christ.
