(Mark chapter 1 verse 15).



The Gospel

What is the Gospel?

The word “gospel” means “good news”. It is summed up in the Bible as: “Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures” (1 Corinthians 15 verse 3).

What are sins?

The breaking of God’s Law (1 John 3 verse 4).

What is God's Law?

Many know it as the 10 Commandments. Jesus summarised it as follows: “You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul and with all your mind” and “You shall love your neighbour as yourself” (Matthew 22 verses 37-39).

Who has sinned?

The Bible says “All have sinned and fall short of God’s glory” (Romans 3 verse 23).

What is the effect of sinning?

The Bible says: “God is a just judge and God is angry with the wicked every day” and “the wages of sin is death” (Psalm 7 verse 11 and Romans 6 verse 23).

One day God will judge everyone. There is a real place of punishment where we all deserve to spend eternity - away from God (Matthew 25 verses 31-46).

How can I escape such a fate?

We cannot save ourselves; it is impossible. However, God CAN save us, though His son Jesus Christ! “The wages of sin is death, *but* the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord” (Romans 6 verse 23).

Who is Jesus Christ?

Jesus Christ is the Son of God. He came and lived on this earth over 2000 years ago. He lived a perfect life, and then died a cruel unjustified death.

On the third day he rose again from the dead! Jesus’ death was not an accident but the central part of God’s plan to save people from their sins.

How can God save us through Jesus Christ?

The Bible says: “You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly” (Romans 5 verse 6).

Jesus Christ lived the life that the sinner has not lived and then died the death the sinner deserves. Jesus has provided the way in which human beings can have their sins forgiven and thus be right with God.

How can I be saved?

Truly and sincerely repent (be deeply sorry for and turn away from) your sins and trust only in the Lord Jesus’ death and resurrection to save you. This requires us to humbly come before God in prayer and seek His forgiveness. Do not doubt that God is willing to receive those who come to Him in such a spirit!
